

## Louisiana EPSCoR Appointments at Oak Ridge National Laboratory

### Eligibility

- Graduate students

### Duration of Appointments

- 10 to 12 weeks

### Provisions from ORNL

- A faculty member will receive a stipend based on his or her academic salary, in addition to the EPSCoR travel allowance of \$500 per week and maximum of \$1,000 in transportation costs.
- Graduate students will receive a stipend of \$100 per week in addition to the EPSCoR travel allowance of \$500 per week and up to \$1,000 in transportation costs.

### The Experience

Each faculty member, graduate student, or faculty/student team will be assigned a mentor at ORNL who will guide the individuals or group toward the completion of a research project that is related to the academic goals of the participants and the mission of ORNL. Placement of LA EPSCoR-approved candidates is contingent upon availability of funds, staff, and programs at ORNL.
